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WAPPY

Writing, Acting & Publishing Project 4 Youngsters

WAPPY is a literary initiative, which was first set up under the umbrella of the Positive Awareness Charity in April 2008, with financial sponsorship from **Youth & Connexions Summer Uni Ealing 2008**, with the prime aim of developing the creative writing skills of up to fifteen young people (ages 11 – 14 years) from multi - ethnic backgrounds, living in Ealing and neighbouring West London boroughs, and train them to become skilled performers of their creative work which they will subsequently have published. Since 2008 we have grown from strength to strength; having won extended funding from the London borough of Ealing in April 2009 and 2010 we have been able to extend our remit to broaden the age range, now from 10 to 15 years old (and beyond), and apart from the summer project (which runs from around the third week of July to mid - August) **WAPPY** also offers a weekly Friday workshop (5.00 pm to 7.00 pm) from mid - September 2010 to March ending 2011. At the end of each programme the **WAPPY** Final Showcase is organised so that our members can perform their creative work including a collective **WAPPY** Tale (which they have created or reworked and narrated and supported by the **WAPPY** team) in front of a live audience, including their families and community supporters.

In May 2010 various **WAPPY** members have had some of their works selected for the **Word 4 Haiti** publication by the Black Londoners Appeal to help raise funds for survivors of the Haiti Earthquake: <http://www.catchavibe.co.uk/black-londoners-appeal-for-haiti/8025/>. Having partnered with the **London Metropolitan Archives** earlier this year, following the performance of our members at the 5th Huntley Archives Conference, we are also in the process of publishing our own anthology with Bogle L'Ouverture Press, veteran pioneering UK black publishers. The LMA is one of our financial sponsors for publishing our future anthology. At this year's Acton Carnival **WAPPY** has designed the signage with materials supplied by the Ealing Events Team

We are based in Hanwell at the **London Life Line Academy**, (79 Uxbridge Road, W7 3SU), near the Golds Gym) – a self – contained, safe building with sizable rooms, a kitchen, a spacious garden and other essential amenities that facilitate child - centred learning.
